## HIPPR FRAMEWORK

**PURPOSE:** "—to carry the message to the addict who still suffers." ( Trad. 5)

### STRUCTURE:

The HIPPR Chair shall act as "...point of decision and accountability..." (Concept 5)

The committee shall be led by a "steering committee" ( re:ASC) comprised of Chair, Vice-chair, Secretary, and Treasurer/Literature. If sufficient trusted servants are unavailable, steering committee members may fulfill multiple duties.

HIPPR responsibilities can be further delegated among an H&I coordinator, Phonenumber coordinator, and PR coordinator. If sufficient trusted servants are unavailable, steering committee members may fulfill multiple duties. For example, Chair may serve as H&I coordinator, Secretary as Phonenumber coordinator and Treasurer/Literature as PR coordinator. Chair and Vice-chair should be prepared to manage all facets as needed.

Further division of labor shall be dependent upon necessity and availability of " effective leadership..."(Concept 4)

Each position shall be empowered to fulfill functions of any vacant positions under guidance of committee conscience. (Concept 6)

H&I, Phonenumber, and PR activities shall follow basic NAWS guidelines with structural variations inherent to consolidation of trusted servant positions.

Further refinements of this framework shall be made through committee conscience, based on the Twelve Steps, Traditions, and Concepts for NA Service. For example: clean time requirements, length of service terms, scope of responsibility, etcetera shall evolve based upon need and availability of servants. NWAANA ASC shall have final approval and cooperate in facilitating this process.

Vice-chair: serve as Chair's proxy.

Secretary: record subcommittee minutes and maintain consolidated records.

Treasurer/Literature: maintain financial records; purchase and distribute literature.

H&I Coordinator: conduct orientations; schedule panel members; promote participation from fellowship; maintain contact with Regional H&I.

Phonelines Coordinator: conduct orientations; promote participation from fellowship; maintain contact with Regional phone chair.

PR Coordinator: identify best use of resources for increasing public awareness of Narcotics Anonymous; promotes participation from fellowship; maintains contact with Regional PR.

NA Fellowship: provide support necessary to fulfilling primary purpose through service.

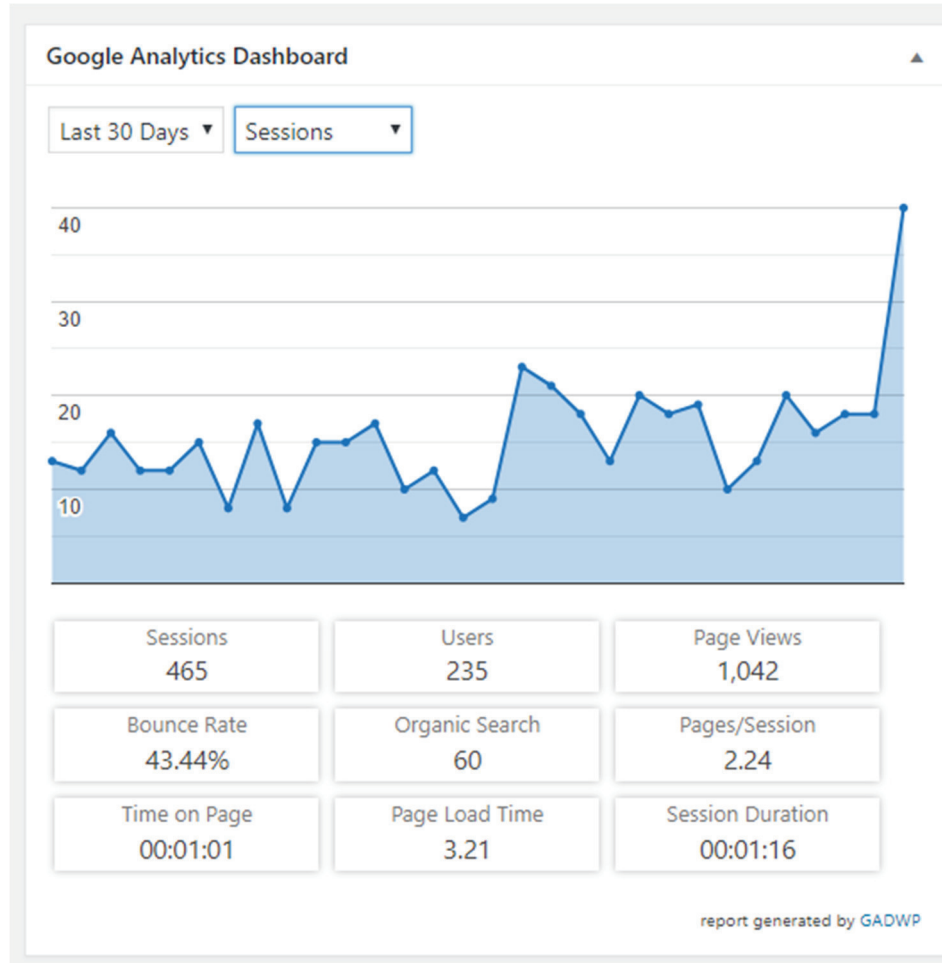

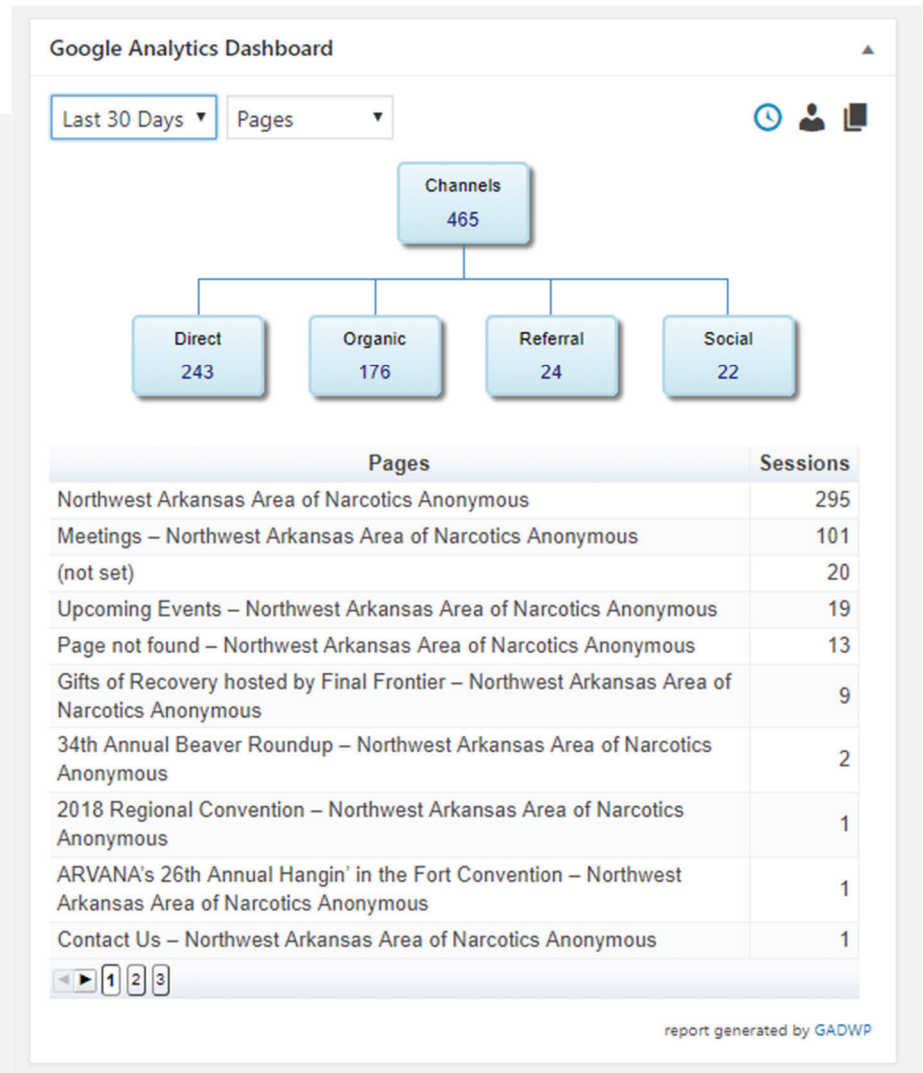
## **First Narcotics Anonymous Public Relations Week**

This shows how many times our website is being accessed in the last 30 days. As you can see, we are usually getting between 10-20 hits per day.

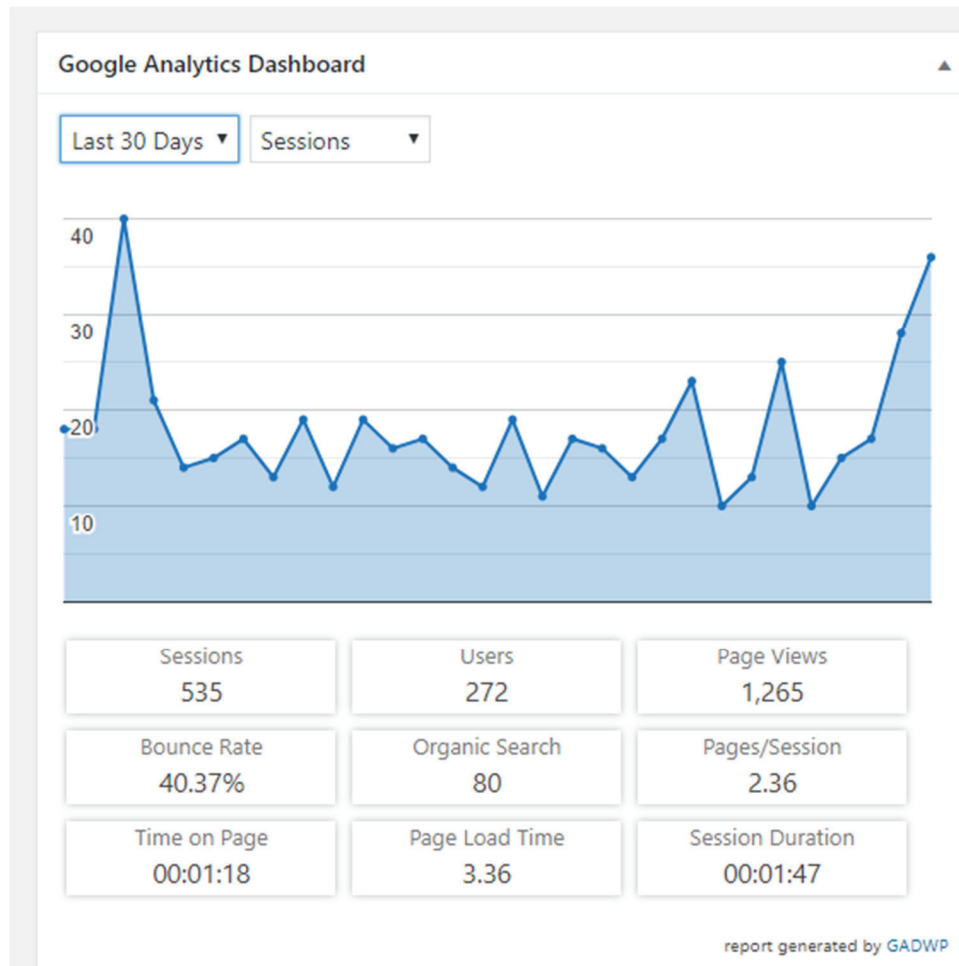


This shows where those users are going for information within our website. The significant majority are searching for meetings and coming in next are events.
