The Activities Committee this past year contributed 25% of each event from October 2018 – April 2019 for a total of \$390.00.

Activities launched a new Event for NWAANA this year – Rockin' Unity. We anticipate being able to have live music in either 2020 or 2021. The sooner the better!

I feel that every event this year had very good attendance from each NWA Home Group and am Looking Forward to seeing our Unity Continue to Grow!

Beaver Round-Up 2019 was a huge success! HP works in Inspirational and Mysterious Ways! Never Doubt it!

1. The Pre-Registration that was offered this year contributed 1/3 of all registrations. This needs to be continued as it allows Activities operating funds throughout the year with continuous cash flow.
2. Shirt designs were great, and the solid shirts offered did not sell quite as well as hoped – but – I would like to have those continue as there's still a market for them. Suggest an 85/15 ratio of Tie-Dye to Solids next year.
3. The Home Group Quilt was Beautiful, and it auctioned off @ \$900.00.
4. The Speakers, though not intended this way, turned out to talk about Recovery in almost every aspect of relationships that there is. Romantic Recovery, Generational Recovery, and Recovery during split with a significant other. We had a speaker with a medical emergency that prevented him from coming, a speaker switching to another speaking slot, and a last-minute speaker – and it all worked out just as our HP intended!
5. I would like to see whoever is chairperson going forward to get pictures each year of all our speakers together and all the Activities committee together to put on FB going forward (provided these participants want their pictures on FB). These members inspire us by speaking and by working very hard to put on an event that people want to return to each year!
6. Final Accounting Figures show that \$2406.72 was made from BRU 2019. Copy available for anyone that wants to look and income/expense reports.
7. I firmly want to encourage the next Activities Chair to utilize ESH from previous chairpersons – but to embrace making a change if you see something that works more efficiently.

I believe the Activities Prudent Reserve is \$5500.00 with all funds over that to be given to ASC after this year's Beaver Round-up.

The Activities Account has a balance of \$8942.16 today and I'm writing a check to NWAANA for \$3442.16.

In closing – I appreciate the opportunity to serve as Activities Vice Chair and Chairperson over the last 2 years. I'm looking forward to relaxing at BRU next year! *I will* put my Toes in the Water and Ass in the Sand right after my 2 hours of Service work!


