ASC Activities Report

November 9, 2019



Soups & Sorcery 2019 was a good event, and I appreciate everyone that came out! Livin' Clean was very thoughtful and attentive to whatever needed to be done at the event and for Clean-Up afterwards. Thank you again and I appreciate ya'll being so helpful!

Anywhere there is an NA Event Our Message is being carried. Even if only 2 people show up – The primary purpose is fulfilled. 'It's not about the money – It's about the Fellowship'.

<u>Let me be very direct – it is about both. Our area cannot afford to have non profitable events.</u> Our ASC depends on any Event to pay for itself and keep enough funds for Beaver Round-up to continue in the future. In addition, a percentage is given back to the ASC after every event. This started as soon as I realized it was a point of contention.

And Then we have Halloween 2019. I didn't want to do the event, only put the barest of efforts into it. I planned and gathered almost everything. I needed help loading and Frank M came to help me when I called him at the last minute for his help. He's always there when I ask him. I hope Project Based Event Committee's are in our near future!

There is and/or was controversy about the outside vendor and I'm going to get my version said now.

- 1. I received a request from Shaun P. in FSM, an NA Approved Vendor, to sell merchandise at the event.
- 2. I sent out an e-mail requesting a GC as to yes or no about his presence and let members know that he offered to return 10% of proceeds back to the area for letting him set up.
- 3. I received the simple majority needed for him to set up and he was notified.
- 4. I received a respectful e-mail from a group expressing concerns about Vendors being allowed at our events.
- 5. I receive another e-mail that critiqued everything about how the vote was handled.

I refuse to be graded. I have been extremely diligent regarding record keeping while I have been Activities Chairperson. All financial accounting and analysis by Activities can be found and substantiated in every report since I was elected.

I have compiled an analysis of whether this Vendor's presence detracted from reducing the average amount spent by attending members for every event from Halloween 2018 – Halloween 2019 – for a total of 5 events.

Please note, the last column is the average amount spent per person at our events. This shows the Halloween 2019 event where Basic Bros Attire was invited to set up inside was also the event that members spent the most money per number of persons attending out of all 5 events. It was also the smallest number of attendees that we had at an event.

Our members have a right to make informed decisions, and by giving facts followed up with actual sales numbers from each event, our members can have a true Group Conscience vote.

Outside of sales numbers, I would be remiss if I didn't point out the possibility of additional people and/or money being spent at any event – <u>just because</u> they knew Basic Bros. Attire was going to be there. Happens at Beaver Round-Up all the time. Merchandising is a definite draw – not a deterrent – at any fundraising event!

The Net Profit was \$385.00. Basic Bros contributed \$120.00 worth of merchandise as well as gave 60.00 for the 10% proceeds he offered above – this is a total of \$180.00 – which is almost ½ of the net profits for the entire event!

Soups and Sorcery 2019 is the last area event I will be the default Area Activities Chairperson. My Husband is having a major surgery on December 17 and will be in the hospital about a week. His recovery time is estimated to be 6-12 months- not weeks- months. My wedding vows are more important than being at any party.

I am leaving all the Activities related material here today. If necessary, I will resign as Vice-Chairperson in order to not perform these duties any longer. If that means no activities going forward until an Activities Chairperson is found – then so be it. New Year's Eve is right around the corner.
