### NWAANA Activities Report - September 14, 2019

Opening Bank Balance for Activities is \$4,850.00. There has been no activity in the Activities bank account since July 16, 2019 – as expected since no events.

The nominated Activities Chairperson is withdrawing her nomination. Since my July 2019 Activities Sub-Committee report did not say specifically that I was resigning, I believe this means I am still Chairperson of the Activities Sub-Committee.

Page 8 states "when an office is vacant, and there is no one willing or able to serve, the duties of the vacant position <u>shall be assigned to another trusted servant</u> as recommended by the NWAASC <u>Chairperson when the vacant position is an office and as recommended by the NWAACC Vice-Chairperson when the vacant position is a standing subcommittee Chairperson.</u>

- 1. This is somewhat open to interpretation-it could be interpreted as the Chairperson could assign duties to another trusted servant and the Vice-Chairperson could assign duties to another trusted service.
- 2. The current interpretation and practice, is the Chairperson assumes the duties of any vacant Trusted servants Vice-Chairperson, treasurer, and Secretary. The Vice-Chairperson assumes the duties of any vacant Sub-committee Chairperson. I believe this needs to be clarified while we are currently updating the Guidelines for NWAASC.

Due to the above 2 reasons, it still looks like I am still the Activities Chairperson. Hence, 2 ASC Positions.

Halloween is next month, and our area usually holds the event at the VA Auditorium, and it's closed. Last Year we held it at Peaceful Dozen Meeting Facility, and it was very crowded. 2017 Net Profits on Halloween was \$259.00 and 2018 was \$508.12. Neither year did we pay rent.

Rent on most facilities that are not home group meeting locations are usually \$75-\$100 per hours. If we rented for 4 hours, it would be \$400.00 out of net profits for any event.

I do not believe we can afford to pay rent unless we have a very large turnout. We have 2 options:

- 1. To have a home group step up and have the meeting at their meeting facility.
- 2. For this Area Not to have a Halloween Event this year in order to avoid losing money.

I need input in open share today, and I need a solution offered if any home group will get permission to hold this event at their meeting facility ASAP as Halloween is approaching and Activities needs time to plan.
