OLD BUSINESS:

- ASC Password and Resources list draft - take back to groups for discussion. *Are these the items we want to collect information about and are there other items that need to be on the list? (it should be password protected and shared ONLY with the guidance committee) *Leave in Old Business until complete
- Convention fundraiser: Selling raffle tickets for \$10 each to win a 2 night stay + registration + t-shirt (special vote will be taken with all groups since we do not have quorum)**Passed via email vote*

OPEN SHARE DISCUSSION:

- Alicia - Area guidelines state that when there is a vacancy and no one willing to serve, the duties will be assigned to another trusted servant or assumed by the Vice Chair, which we don't have. I was at the Regional meeting, I'm the Chair of the Area so I would have assumed the duties, but I had other responsibilities to attend to during the meeting. The RCM's position was technically up and the person representing us was nominated for the position. At the end of the day, the RSC meeting had already happened and our voice from the Area was heard. I'll accept responsibility.
- Scott - based on our guidelines we did have a willing person that was already nominated and that needed to be taken into consideration.
- Marc - that isn't my issue. There seems to be a double standard and I can't help but start to take it personally. My homegroup is starting to see it that way too. I was chastised and told I didn't know how NA works when as chair I made a similar decision. Our current chair and RCM nominee didn't ask the groups to be informed first like I was told. From that event, then 2 months later I was told I wouldn't be nominated by this area because I don't take things back to groups. Do we attack someone because we don't like them? Last month there was a report that said I was to blame for getting offended as much as the party that attacked me. That can be read from our minutes last month. I have no issue with the chair's decision. I believe she did the right thing, but why is this allowed to happen without any uproar and I'm viewed negatively for not having things go back to groups. Out of all the areas in the Region, my own Area voted against me for at the Region. Even the nominee didn't understand why we voted for that. Does this make me want to come back here?
- Karen - I've missed most of everything that's been going on. I thought it was clear that we go down the list of groups and that's what you did. I don't know what personality thing was involved, but we all look at our part in it. From what I've heard, the personalities have to stay out of it. It's hard to do service when you have a lot of strong personalities who all have experiences in recovery to contribute. We just need to work through this because we are here to carry the message of Narcotics Anonymous. I had to step away because my plate was full. It's sad that our personalities are sometimes bigger than our purpose. It's no one person's fault. Our ego gets big. Guidelines are important, but they are just that, guidelines. I can appreciate that you aren't splitting hairs about the decision she made. It was probably done at the very last minute. I know it feels personal. If we don't tell our groups that Area needs support, then service suffers.
- Scott - that's our 12th Tradition. Welcome to the club of big personalities. I've been in this area for a very long time and no one in this room has seen as much in this Area as I have. NA comes 1st for some of us, not all of us. Each group has a personality too. I completely understand I have to

stop myself and remember that I'm here to represent Livin Clean. I've been told all kinds of things about myself and my personality. The 12th traditions are non negotiable. I've learned them and if that's why you don't like me, then I don't care. Sometimes being human doesn't come out well. I wasn't here in Area and all I got was a report and a grievance report. The notes I got weren't the greatest and so I'm still catching up on what happened. Our GSR wasn't here so he was going off the minutes. I don't know how many times the guidelines have been changed by different people and trusted servants. Regarding the grievance request, Livin Clean's understanding is that a vote should be done anonymously and our name shouldn't have been mentioned. We have steps and processes for this. Maybe we need some guidelines about how someone's votes are not shared. Do we need an ad hoc to develop guidelines for this? Who decides who is on an ad hoc to change or update guidelines? I know at my homegroup, when someone is elected, we first ask questions and then they leave the room before we vote. We don't have people ask why they didn't get a vote. If I have a problem about how things are being voted, that's for me to work the steps. If we have an issue as an Area, then we need to take it back to the Traditions. I heard earlier about the Region's procedures. The Region works for us as an Area and the Areas works for the Groups and Members. When we have a grievance, where do we take it? I need to first talk with my sponsor before I bring it up.

- Alicia - to clarify, this was a nomination from the RSC and we use consensus based decision making. We ask if there is any opposition to something and if there is, then we ask if they can state the opposition and if they are willing to step aside.
- Scott - in a voting situation, there needs to be anonymity.
- Marc - there's been a few comments about principles before personalities. What I'm hearing is, Marc this is a personality issue. There's also been suggestions about talking to my sponsor and working the steps. I did all that and that's why I came back here with a 10th concept. I wasn't here when my nomination was voted on so I had the right to ask what was said since no one asked me if the statements that were made were true. The grievance committee came back and said that both parties were at fault. The implication there is that I felt attacked in the meeting and responding in that way was at fault, but how I see it is that I'm standing up for principles. The principle of integrity, honest information being out there, my boundaries about what I will and will not tolerate. If you don't choose to respect my boundaries, then that's my HP saying that these people are not for you. If they choose to respect my boundaries, then my HP says that I should continue to grow with these people. I still don't know the answer to that yet because I haven't heard anyone say "You're absolutely right Marc. No one should have called you a dictator. Nobody should have told you you don't know how NA works. Nobody should have said you don't consult groups. Nobody should have made an accusation about your nomination without checking with you about whether that was true." That was a false statement. If you come in here to vote on someone and you say something not true, I expect people to stand up for principle not personality, and ask where the proof is and if it's true. I'm standing on principles and I'm waiting to hear that I was right, that my boundaries are respected, and I'm sorry.
- Karen - Your experience here sucked and I'm sorry for you. I believe you are a huge benefit to NA. Some egos are just big. I hope you don't get run off by this. Look at us all today. We keep coming back and grow. The guidelines are clear, for someone to say that you did the wrong thing by picking the next group in line is just wrong. I hope that we put it to rest. I want to come back to service, but I don't want to come back to this every time. I'm willing to sit through it, yes. There are people who come and say they won't come back because of this stuff. This is about more than just not using. This is about relationships.
- Marc - I think it's about developing relationships too and that's why I'm setting boundaries.

I attended a Conference Participant meeting on 6/12/21

The discussion was about the WSC 2022 and Financial impact of Conference. Considering the possibility of offering a web participant option. A Straw Poll taken on 6/12/21.

In person WSC – worldwide pandemic Covid 19 is subsiding in US. However, globally – it is still a pandemic. Travel restrictions are still a problem. Certain countries have travel restrictions into the US.

NAWS Financial situation – Currently in the black currently. But this does not include WSC in-person. The financial impact is ½ million dollars.

We are considering a hybrid WSC, or meet fewer days. This could save \$26,000 a day.

Straw poll taken on 6/21/21:

 - Yes – 75
 - No – 7
 - Undecided – 12

- If a significant number were unable to attend do you believe it would be possible to have an in person WSC that was in keeping with our spiritual principles and the reason we gather
 - Yes – 35
 - No – 40
 - Undecided – 18
