- “Spiritual Principle a Day” book was approved at WSC - you can start using it in your meetings
- If you are signed up to receive the JFT reading daily via email you should automatically get signed up for the SPAD daily email too
- Some discussion about having RSC fund the RD and the AD to travel to WSC with an “opt-in” option to request the funds for RD if still needed. The default would be RSC fund, but if they still need WSC to provide funds then they will receive them.
- **Old business:**
 - Motion #7 to have the service based campout with a budget of \$4000 failed, but not because of the money. The feedback at Region was that they didn’t want another campout since there are already 17 campouts scheduled. They would rather use the funds for around the RSC which would be smaller local events that make the RSC more appealing.
 - All CAR/CAT motions passed at WSC
- **Open Share:**
 - Lonestar has failed to pay us their share the last three years in a row we believe they should not be invited back
 - Ark drug & program - never the NA program and it is to the treatment facility center not our NA - we need a cease and desist and letter.
 - Office depot - discount card is changing and price will go up. And do it online. Store employee discount.
 - is a bank registered under name or EIN - we have EIN number. If we take in more than 5k, do we need to file taxes? Alicia - no because no one gets paid and not income. WSC says we should check with a tax person.
 - phone line - currently no phone line - have answering service. NO 800 number. We can get a new number with Verizon. We haven’t set up an account with them yet. We were trying to port the number over. Why do we need an 800 number - because of treatment centers or jail that need the 800 number.
- **Strategic Planning workshop:** Project should be completed by November 2022 and include 2 training videos/e-learning and documents, 2 RCM forms (one for Regional reports and one to help with note-taking), 3 workshops ready for delivery, and a list of strategies to attract people to service and workshops
- **Guidelines & Policies:** Convention guideline updates were a much bigger undertaking than previously thought as there are many items that are outdated while some are completely missing. Social Media ad-hoc guidelines still not ready, but will be working with G&P to present something next RSC. Archiving policy approved and the admin will begin collecting data.
