

Aug 2023 RSC - Communications Report

Website: All events that have been received are posted on the Regional website. There is a link so that any group, campout, or service body can "submit an event" directly at www.arscna.org. Please use this link even if you don't have all the details or a flier yet. It will help other Areas to show support by not scheduling several events on the same day/weekend when possible. We've been trying out a new feature that will allow you to subscribe to the event calendar and automatically get any events posted to your own calendar. It only works for iPhone and it hasn't been published yet.

It was mentioned yesterday that no minutes from 2023 were posted, so I will follow up and make sure they get posted. I will also ask that the resources be listed more appropriately under that header on the website.

BMLT: All meetings have been updated that we have received. There is currently an audit of meetings that are not currently connected with an ASC or as a Loner group with the RSC. I have made connections with some smaller communities and was able to get a few meetings updated that are still alive and thriving in rural Arkansas. This work is not done, but should be wrapped up in the next couple weeks.

Phoneline: Update to the patch list has been done to include the volunteers that were present at the last RSC workshop. There are several other volunteers on the list and it is unknown when they were each last trained. I have been going through to update that information as well. It will be completed by the next RSC. 
