It has taken me a minute to get my footing and catch up on all that's been going on with the information I was able to gather and with the support of Wendy and Crystal. Good news is that there's still more we can do!! Here's a glimpse into what is happening and some other info about HIPPR.

H&I

- Acceptance Recovery has not had meetings going in and I've not received a response back from Ricky about the status of this meeting.
- Eagle Crest Recovery has meetings on the 2nd Monday monthly.
- **Benton County Juvenile Detention Center - status??**
- A Washington county judge is trying to help facilitate getting a meeting into Washington county jail. More will be revealed.
- A new request from Ozark Healing Center has been received and will be discussed at the next subcommittee meeting.
- Sign up genius - all the previous signups had been deleted so I'm not able to access the list of emails for volunteers through there.
- H&I Orientation is required for all volunteers going into facilities. If you want to attend an orientation, please email hippr@naofnwa.org to schedule a time.

Phoneline

- Current volunteers list updated by the RSC. New volunteers must be trained every 2 years to remain on the list.

Public Relations

- Poster Days - Crystal S. will be setting up some "poster hanging" dates. Keep an eye out for more info.
- IP Racks - Kathleen G. has been keeping the IP racks (see updated info below)
- PR Booths - I'm getting the current PR booth materials back from Wendy and then will be working on updating the material. No new booth opportunities at this time. If you hear of a community event, we'd love to hear about it to see if we can find volunteers.

IP Racks (update as of last week) - suggested that we get a new stamp with the phoneline # and Area website on it since meeting lists are all gone at these locations and printing enough may not be feasible to keep up with demand.

Sept 2025 ASC Website Report

At the request of the ASC I have continued to maintain the website in the absence of an elected trusted servant or a decision to move to a special worker role for continuity. Here are the updates since we last met in July.

Meetings - The meetings page was updated to only have the BMLT database showing in case the ASC did not have a decision made on how to move forward with website maintenance. This was the easiest way to ensure that the meeting data could be updated through the RSC.

- A new meeting "No Fronts" has been added to the meeting list.
- No Matter What Eureka Springs meeting - notified me that there was one night they weren't meeting and I was able to note that temporary disruption on the meeting list.
- A member has reached out about starting a new meeting in Goshen, AR possibly mid-afternoon weekdays. They are working on finding a location so if you know anyone in that part of town or are willing to help support, let me know and I will connect you.
- I did receive information this past Sunday about the meeting in Huntsville being closed, so it was removed from the website. I was contacted on Wednesday by a home group member asking that the meeting be put back on the list and confirmed it was still meeting. The group had been in communication with the facility about certain members having key access, but that has been resolved and they are still meeting. Please announce this in meetings since it has been announced previously that they closed the meeting.

Events - Events submitted were added including the recurring BRU 2026 planning meetings, the Arkansas Region "Basic Text for Jails" project meeting, and the upcoming virtual CAR workshops.

BRU 2026 Registration - There are activities committee volunteers who are interested in learning more about setting this up on the backend of the website with the hopes they can support and maintain the online registration for the BRU. Depending on the outcome of today's motion, I would ask that the ASC allow this to be setup and then set to inactive until they are ready to turn it on. They have indicated they would like to do that after the Regional Convention in October to cut down on any confusion.

Emails - We had a massive influx of spam emails sent through the website using the new forms for H&I and PR requests. They also came through the main contact form. There were several thousands of emails received in the matter of a few minutes before I could get into the website and shut it down and add additional layers of human authentication for each access point. This influx caused all the email addresses to flood inboxes on both our email server and anyone who receives email through forwarding or directly for an naofnwa email account (on their personal device). There was a massive clean up done for all the emails that were affected on the email server for the following email addresses:

- HIPPR email - approximately 1,500+ emails
- Webmaster email - approximately 1,000 emails
- Events email - approximately 500 emails
- Activities email - approximately 900+ emails
- main domain email - for email "bounce backs - over 2,000 emails

Wordpress updates: The website has several backups and updates that need to be made systematically. I have held off on doing this until I know the outcome of the ASC's decision today. This is not something I wanted to start and then not be prepared to support if more support was needed. There

are a series of things that need updating and they need to be done with care. Also, the current "theme" the website uses was paid for by me when I first changed the website back in circa 2017-2018. I have maintained the license for it as I use it for several other businesses and have never charged the ASC for its use since it doesn't cost me any extra. However, if we continue to use it, I will need to update the license info each time it renews to re-verify the license is still active. This only comes into play if I'm no longer the person maintaining the website, so I wanted to share that in this report today for transparency and future planning. Updates to the "theme" are not required, but sometimes there's new functionality that can only be used if the license is verified.

NOTE: The Webservant role is more than just posting updates—it's maintaining the domain and hosting, managing email routing, backups, online registrations, and troubleshooting. While it doesn't take many hours, it does require consistency and technical skill to avoid disruption. This isn't about personalities—it's about principles: continuity, reliability, and protecting the ability of the addict who still suffers to find us.

****Website domain name & hosting renewal is due on December 17th for a cost of \$240 before tax.**
