RSC Motions: M2026-02-02 - APPROVED

Increase seed money for Arkansas Regional Convention from \$10,000 to \$12,000. INTENT: To provide ample funds to fulfill the mission and purpose of the Convention Committee, which is to plan, coordinate, and conduct the biennial Arkansas Regional Convention of Narcotics Anonymous, given the rising costs of all products and services related to conducting said convention. Policy Changes: 1.28 Convention Proceeds Disbursements, 1.a. Convention seed Money is \$10,000.00. Additional Context: The 2025 Regional Convention Budget was \$19,820.00; actual expenses were \$22,932.65; gross revenue was \$28,372.27. \$12,000.00 is far short of what is needed, but moves us in the appropriate direction.

RSC Motions: M2026-02-03 - APPROVED

To adopt the ARSCNA Policy, Social Media Policy, and Treasurer's Policy as part of the Ad Hoc Communications Project adopted from M2025-05-04. INTENT: To update, modernize, and clarify the policies of the ARSCNA. Additional Context: Was work shopped with the regional service committee members on January 15th and February 7th, 2026. What does HIPPR stand for??

- H&I - bring meetings into members who can't get out to regular meetings
- Phoneline - answer calls from addicts and the public
- Public Relations
 - Poster Days - coordinated effort to hang NA poster in the community
 - Public Relations Booths - information booths at community or recovery events
 - Public Relations Presentation - providing information about the existence and viability of NA to the community (ie. professional orgs & groups)
 - IP Racks - placing Information Pamphlets are designated locations in NA racks

H&I:

- Eagle Crest - currently going in on the 2nd Monday monthly. We are now committing 3 panel members to each visit so there is always a backup.
- Washington County Jail - applications are available for trained H&I volunteers. Ordering 15 English and 5 Spanish Basic Texts for the facility. Still working on days and times to go in.
- Benton County Detention Center - We have connected with the jail chaplain through Northwest Arkansas Chaplain Ministries. She met with us, received Basic Text and PR materials, and is actively welcoming NA into the facility. The clearance process runs through NW AR Chaplain Ministries at nwachaplains.com. Steps include application submission, orientation, fingerprinting, two online courses, and an in-person identity verification appointment. Full requirements at nwachaplains.com/Ministry%20Requirements.htm. We may not complete the full process before the spring semi-annual orientation. In the meantime we are exploring getting literature into the facility and setting up an informational booth for deputies.
- We are researching loading the NA Basic Text and IPs onto the tablets used in both Benton and Washington County jails, following a process recommended by the Ohio Region PR committee. More to come.
- Now that we have completed our booth and PR training, we will be reaching out to the following facilities to schedule H&I panels: Salvation Army Fayetteville, Vantage Point, Community Rebuilding Initiative, and Ozark Healing Center.

Public Relations:

- Booths and Presentations - Mini booth training held April 26 with 8 members present. Megan and Amanda completed the first Benton County Drug Court Phase 1 presentation in April using a script the committee developed. We will go in every two months per the schedule provided. Washington County Drug Court has requested the same presentation - update to follow once scheduling is confirmed. Booth opportunities are upcoming and we will be scheduling PR presentations with the facilities listed above now that our training is complete.

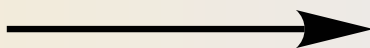
